Brian Branch Price Photographer Plainfield Veterans: A Pictorial View

The Plainfield Public Library announces a new exhibit by guest photographer, Brian Branch Price. ***Plainfield Veterans: A Pictorial View***. The exhibit arrives just in time to celebrate Veterans Day, and includes nearly three dozen contemporary photographs of Plainfield veterans.

In 2015, Mr. Branch Price was awarded a mini-grant from the Plainfield Cultural & Heritage Commission. This was the first such grant that was awarded for visual arts. The mini-grant focused on a pictorial view of Plainfield veterans. The grant was used for research and materials for presentation on display at the Plainfield Public Library.

Brian began his photographic career while in his junior year at Plainfield High School. A former staff photographer for the Associated Press, he now serves the community and the global reach as a photojournalist and portrait photographer.

He is a recipient of the National Headliner, one of the country's oldest and most prestigious journalistic awards. An active member of the National Association of Black Journalists, he serves on the Visual Task Force.

Plainfield Veterans will be on display on the Main Reading Room wall through the end of November.
