- 5. Westtown Boarding School Report, Chester County, Philadelphia, 1796. Printed, fire damage. *This was a Quaker / Friends' boarding school*
- 6. Indenture between Mr. and Mrs. Richard Frazee (Westfield) and J. Line (New Providence), 1824
- 7. Handwritten minutes of the 12th annual reunion of the survivors of the 6th regiment New York Heavy Artillery, 1901
- 8. Sale of property belonging to Joseph Allen of Elizabeth, NJ, 1749. Damaged in 2 pieces
